YOUNG LEADERS CREATING CHANGE IN THEIR

NEIGHBORHOODS

Ten young leaders from the Detroit Shoreway, Cudell, and Edgewater neighborhoods are the inaugural members of the new Youth Leadership Council (YLC). These youth are speaking up about their goals and dreams for their neighborhoods and themselves. They have been building connections with each other, neighbors, and community development staff since their August 2nd kickoff retreat

The YLC program, part of the MyCom network, supports neighborhood leaders ages 14 through 24, with each participant receiving a \$500 stipend for their time and effort throughout the year. Youth are required to complete 40 hours of volunteer service in the neighborhoods and will attend monthly Council meetings with topics ranging from time management to gender and racial equity.

The SAGE program, ages 50+, meets Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays for lunch, exercise, and discussion. The Trans Wellness program hosts peer learning every Monday and Wednesday, 3-7pm. The Queer Youth Initiative (QYou) for ages 11-20 provides safe, drop-in hours every Monday, Wednesday, and Friday, 3-7:30pm. The QYou #PowerUpPowerOut leadership development program, ages 14-19, will welcome its next cohort soon, tentatively Nov. 6th.



Groups, churches, and employers can request Education and Advocacy programs, such as 101 trainings or neighborhood "Talk and Tours."


