WHAT IS WEATHERIZATION?

Weatherization is the process of protecting one's home against the elements, decreasing energy consumption, and improving energy efficiency. As part of the Resilient Cleveland initiative, Detroit Shoreway Community Development Organization (DSCDO) is proud to recommend the CHN Housing Partners (CHN) Home Weatherization Program to neighborhood residents. Homeowners and renters may be eligible to receive the following FREE services:

- Home insulation
- Energy-efficient appliances
- Light bulbs
- New furnace
- New hot water tank

Homeowners and renters alike can expect to save up to 30% on their monthly utility bills.

If your household income exceeds the CHN guidelines, please note that Cleveland Energy\$aver® is another service that offers low cost energy efficiency packages with financing available for all income levels.

SUCCESS STORIES

Mr. Diaz, a longtime Detroit Shoreway resident, received home weatherization services in 2017. Victor's home improvements included a new hot water tank, upper floor insulation, energy efficient light bulbs, and even a refrigerator.

"The refrigerator was too old so they replaced it," Mr. Diaz said. He added, "[The] electric bill is coming in low each month, much lower than it was before."

Ms. Smitley, another longtime neighborhood resident, received CHN home weatherization services in the fall of 2017.



"[CHN employees] worked around my schedule, were very kind, and very respectful while working in my home. With being disabled and on limited income I never would have been able to afford it." Ms. Smitley explained.
